**WARNING SYSTEM TEST FOR
HOOPA SAVE THE DATE**

- WHEN:** Wednesday, June 27th, 2018, at 11:00 a.m.
- WHERE:** Hoopa Valley Indian Reservation.
- HOW:** Activation of NOAA Weather Radios and Outdoor Sirens.
- WHY:** **To TEST the Mass Notification Siren Warning System** to ensure it works properly during a real emergency.

HOW THIS TEST WILL AFFECT YOU:

If you are listening to KIDE 91.3 FM Tribal Radio on Wednesday morning June 27th., expect to hear notification that Hoopa Fire Department and Office of Emergency Services will be testing the Mass Notification Siren Warning System and that this is only a test. If you have a NOAA weather radio with the Public Alert feature, the radio will automatically turn on and you will hear a message that will indicate this is a Mass Notification Siren Warning System test.

When you hear the warning test in Hoopa on June 27th, 2018, at 11:00 a.m.

- **You do NOT need to take any action.**
- **Do NOT call 911 or local authorities.**
- **Do NOT evacuate your home or business.**

THIS IS ONLY A TEST!!
