Hoopa Tribal Council has a regular scheduled council meeting on Thursday. Okay. We have an item on that agenda. We have our Corporation for Public Broadcasting CARE fund allocation. We want to get that budget approved so that we can start purchasing some much needed equipment, so we can enhance our broadcast and we have some plans for the future. So that's on the agenda.

I spoke some of that with my Friday edition guest, Gavin Dehl, little highlights of that. The other thing that's happening is the Kim Memorial Library has curbside service while all the Humboldt County libraries have now curbside service. So we have that PSA that talks about the hours that they will be operating and they have a drop off box that's going to be open certain days, at certain times, I believe starts on Wednesday to Saturday. The idea there is you're going to get the box where you can bring your overdue books back, drop them off there. And then they're going to let them sit there for a number of days. Let those little bacteria starve to death. So they can handle them. So they got that figured out takes X number of days for everything to kind of wear out in bacteria to dissipate whatever bacteria does, decompose. Yeah. Anyway, then they'll, they'll process the books. They did waive the fees, overdue fees. So don't worry about that. You don't have to come down with a wad of cash here and say, Hey, no, no, no, I don't need that. But the books are, again being recycled and you can order your books, check out their catalog and find out what books you'd like to have go to humlib.org, humlib.org and you can get more information about the library hours, get the catalog, you can order some books and then they'll let you know when those arrive. I imagine I'm talking for them now.

And you can go to the curbside service, you know, bring them out to you, you know, certain hours So, we'll be announcing that we'll have this schedule on our website calendar and posted on our homepage as well. So we'll get that information out there for you. Because it's really important to have that library open and there's the web, the Wi Fi, and ebook service is operating 24 hours a day, seven days a week in the library parking lot.
