Dear Hoopa Valley Tribal Members,

On behalf of the Tribal Council, I would like to invite you to our General Membership Meeting on Saturday September 24, 2022 starting at 9:15 AM in the NF Gym. Attached is the agenda as well as information for logging into the meeting via Zoom. It will be broadcast live on KIDE 91.3 FM as well which can be accessed on the internet at kidefm.org/.

Some of the discussion points you will hear about at the meeting will include: the fact that the Tribe has now reduced the deficit by more than \$ 3 million dollars, the FY 2023 Budget, the grant we received for Valley wide clean up, our new Workforce Development Crew, an update on our efforts to re-acquire 10,000 acres of our aboriginal land in the Pine Creek Watershed to the West of the Reservation, a new Small Business Loan Program we are developing, the development of a new elders housing village in downtown Hoopa, Green Energy/Infrastructure Projects, our ongoing efforts to strengthen our fishing and water rights and much more.

I encourage you to take part in the meeting. Often times all we hear and/or focus on are negative things associated with the Tribe but I can assure you that there are many very positive things happening. It's important that you have the opportunity to hear about the positive things happening and give feedback on those issues as well as in the areas still needing improvement. We have not fixed every issue that has been discussed in past General Meetings but we have certainly made progress and will continue to do so with your input and participation.

There are 3 separate attachments to this letter; this includes the meeting agenda, Zoom information, and a breakdown of the funds received through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). There are also financials available for review on the Tribe's online portal which can be accessed through the Tribe's website at <https://www.hoopa-nsn.gov/> but you must work with Tribal Enrollment (530 625-4364) in order to get a password to access the online portal. As always there will also be written departmental reports available at the meeting which can be shared on the online portal thereafter.
